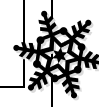

EPA ENFORCES LEAD RULES ON REMODELING CONTRACTORS

The EPA has begun enforcement for its Lead: Renovation, Repair, and Painting rules instituted in April 2010. This is the rule that requires renovators to be certified by the EPA and follow specific guidelines to perform work on homes and child-occupied facilities built before 1978. Certification involves an 8 hour class with 2 hours of hands-on training as well as a \$300 fee. Certification is valid for five years; re-certification is a 4 hour refresher course. Before work begins on a pre-1978 structure, the remodeler must educate the residents with a pamphlet, post warnings, and set up a containment area. Through the rule, certain procedures must be followed for both interior and exterior projects, including verifying the quality of clean-up. Although inspectors do inspect renovation activities, we're told most of the violations come in the form of paperwork violations. To be thorough with your records, copies of the following are required:

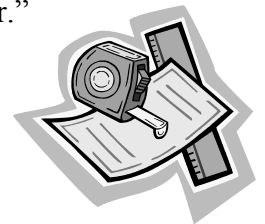


-  Copy of the Certified Renovator Certificate
-  Signed verification receipts of the "Renovate Right" pamphlet by homeowner and/or resident for each job
-  Results of any lead testing, including EPA-recognized test kits
-  Work practice checklist for the job
-  Operation and maintenance records for HEPA vacuums

Penalties for infractions of the Lead Rule range from \$130 to \$37,500 per violation, per day. Many firms have now become certified, but they should be aware that inspections are being instituted and they are indeed fining contractors for not following their described procedures.
